



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (Classes 2018 – 2020)

1. A minimum of 27.5 credits required for graduation must be in the following areas:

Theology	4 credits
English	4 credits
Mathematics	4 credits
Science (Lab)	3 credits
Social Studies*	3 credits
Consumer Education	0.50 credit
Electives	4 credits
Foreign Language	2 credits
Fine Arts	1.0 credit
PE/Health	2 credits

*Includes U.S. History and American Government/Civics

**Exceptions require administrative approval

2. Seniors carry at least seven credits during senior year.
3. Seniors must have 24 credits to graduate.
4. Seniors must pass a test on the Illinois Constitution, the U.S. Constitution, and display of the flag.

Report Cards are issued quarterly. Grades are given in each subject as follows:

F	Below 60
I	Incomplete: work must be completed. This is only issued for extenuating circumstances, such as extended illness. Work must be made up within a two (2) week period.
