1. A minimum of 27.5\* credits required for graduation must be in the following areas:

Theology	4 credits

Science (Lab)	3 credits

Consumer Education	0.50 credit
Electives***	4 credits
Foreign Language	2 credits
Fine Arts	1.0 credit
PE/Health	2 credits

- \*\*\*This requirement may be adjusted for students who participate in Title One
- 2. Seniors carry at least seven credits during senior year.
- 3. Seniors must have 27.5\* credits to graduate.
- 4. Seniors must pass a test on the Illinois Constitution, the U.S. Constitution, and display of the flag.
