



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A minimum of 27* credits required for graduation must be in the following areas:

Theology	3 credits
English	4 credits
Mathematics	4 credits
Science (Lab)	3 credits
Social Studies**	3 credits
Electives***	5 credits
Foreign Language	2 credits
Fine Arts	1.0 credit
PE/Health	2 credits

*Exceptions require administrative approval

**Includes U.S. History, American Government, Civics and Consumer Education

***This requirement may be adjusted for students who participate in Title One

2. Seniors carry at least seven credits during senior year.
3. Seniors must have 27* credits to graduate.
4. Seniors must pass a test on the Illinois Constitution, the U.S. Constitution, and display of the flag.
